

Spirax Sarco – Pressure Equipment Regulations 2014/68/UE

To Whom it may concern,

Spirax Sarco design and manufacture many products that comply with the requirements of the Pressure Equipment Regulations 2014/68/UE.

To satisfy the requirements of the regulations, products are classified according to perceived levels of hazard.

Equipment of a relatively low hazard are classified as 'Sound Engineering Practice' (SEP) based on the reference charts in Annex B of the Pressure Equipment Regulations. Products that are classified as a higher hazard than SEP are required to meet the essential safety requirements of the Pressure Equipment Regulations and bear appropriate CE marking.


Equipment classified according to the charts in Annex B as 'SEP' will be required simply to be designed and manufactured according to Sound Engineering Practice (Ref Part III 9-3). SEP equipment will need to be accompanied by adequate instructions for use and must bear markings to permit identification of the manufacturer or authorised representative established within the community. CE marking must not be affixed to SEP equipment.

Please Note! It is illegal to CE mark 'SEP' products in respect of the Pressure Equipment Regulations, however other European Regulations may be applicable that would invoke appropriate CE marking.
